



Code of Behaviour at the Quarry

The quarry and the adjacent area are property of the diving club Görlitz (TCG). The following rules apply for all visitors (club member and guests). The members have to point the rules out to the guests.

1. The quarry is located in a landscape conservation area. All visitors have to behave accordingly. Unnecessary noise has to be avoided. Dogs have to be leashed. Camping and staying overnight in the landscape conservation area and on the premises of the TCG is prohibited.
2. The access with motor vehicle is restricted to the club members. Other visitors need to have the permission of the club.
3. The number of cars has to be minimised to ensure the optimal transport of diving equipment.
4. On the forest tracks, motor vehicles have to be driven in walking speed to reduce noise and dust as much as possible and to avoid rock slide.
5. Parking of cars is only allowed on the premises of the club or on the public car park. Parking on the neighbouring ground is strictly forbidden.
6. Cultivate good neighbourly relations with the family beside.
7. The facilities at the quarry ground were raised in joint work and have to be maintained by all members. There necessary maintenance is organised by yearly club activities.
8. The trailer, as a daylight accommodation during the cold and wet season, and the oven inside have to be left in clean conditions. The whole ground has to be kept clean. Everybody is responsible for his waste.
9. It is not allowed to leave any objects on the ground without permission of club management.
10. Camp-fires and barbecues are only allowed on the marked place and have to be continuously supervised. When leaving, the fire has to be fully extinguished. In case of warning of wood fires, camp-fires are strictly forbidden. Everybody is responsible to take his waste away and to dispose it.
11. When leaving, the barrier, the sheds, the trailer and the entry to the quarry have to be locked.
12. Strangers should be urged politely to leave the ground. In case of incidents, the police should be called.
13. Guests, who are not members, have to be instructed according to the "rules of diving". The information requested form the divers, which are defined in these rules, have to be documented.
